**AMENDED JUDGMENT**

Defendants Corporation of the BankHouse, Inc., Societe BankHouse, and James F. Pomeroy, II having failed to produce discovery and having been held in contempt, with the sanction of default having entered against each of them; and

Defendant SB Global, Inc. having failed to answer or otherwise defend, and default having entered against it; and

The Court having reviewed the facts admitted and having made certain findings of fact; and

It appearing that none of the defendants is an infant or incompetent person or in the military service of the United States; and

It appearing from the pleadings, proceedings and affidavit of Christopher M. Barber, Philip Clark and Kathleen C. Stone that defendant are indebted, jointly and severally, to plaintiff in the amounts set forth in the affidavits, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that judgment shall enter against defendants, jointly and severally, in favor of plaintiff on each of the counts of the Second Amended Complaint in the total amount of \$10,468,106, comprised of the following elements:

- I. Basic Damages under the following counts in the total amount of \$4,000,000:
  - Count I (Intentional Misrepresentation)
  - Count II (Fraud)
  - Count III (Breach of Contract)
  - Count IV (Conversion)
  - Count VI (federal securities violations under § 12 of the Securities Act of 1933)
  - Count VII ) (Federal Securities Violations under § 10 (b)(5) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934)
  - Count VII (State Securities Violations)
  - Count IX (Breach of Fiduciary Duty)
- II. Prejudgment interest on the contract damages awarded under Count III at the rate of 12% for 68 months (from the breach which occurred on May 29, 1998 to April 13, 2004) in the amount of \$1,720,500
- III. Prejudgment interest on the damages awarded for tort and statutory damages under Count I, II, IV, VI, VII, VIII and IX at the rate of 12% for 25 months (from the commencement of this action on March 22, 2002 to April 13, 2004) in the total amount of \$990,195
- IV. Attorneys' fees and costs in the amount of \$189,510


V. Double damages of an additional \$4,000,000 under Count V for violation of Mass. Gen. Laws c. 93A

VI. Investigation and recovery expenses assessed as additional damages in the amount of \$558,096

VII. The Order for Preliminary Injunction dated July 18, 2002 is converted to a Permanent Injunction and made a part of this judgment.

Post judgment interest to be computed in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 1961.
